Contest: A logo for the Guardians of the Galaxy

All students from your school are invited to participate in the contest for the creation of a final **logo** that will identify the Erasmus Plus Project “**Be the Guardian of the Galaxy Yourself**”.

The logo must be highly representative of the purpose of the project that binds together **5** partner schools from **5 countries: Hungary, Sweden, Portugal, Turkey and Italy**. The contest will temporarily take place in each of the partner schools, and you are strongly recommended to contribute because it is an extremely important task.

The logo will identify the project itself in any manifestation, will be hence reproduced on any of the activities related and any of the materials ensuing.

Submission and format

Each student, or group of students can submit **only one proposal** for a logo. The drawing, or any other material of digital representation, must be one's own **original creation**. Those who submit it, must declare that they are not infringing any other's intellectual property.

Format:

The logo design must also match the requirements for **DIN-A4 format**, be capable of adapting to clear representation once used in any of the common applications, capable of being enlarged or minimized without losing resolution (300 DPI is the recommended size, accordingly).

Technique:

the Logo can be a hand drawing or created using the computer

Deadline for school submission:

Logos must be submitted to the Erasmus+ coordinator of each school by 14th January.

Internal Selection:

Each school will evaluate their proposals and will select the best logo, according to the following criteria:

- Quick identification of the icon/logo with the general purpose of the project (Guardians of the Galaxy) and relation among the participant countries.
- Innovative and creative design
- Adaptability of the logo to clear presentation and reproduction on common applications.

Final Selection

The selected logo from each school will be forwarded to the Project Coordinating Partner by the 21st January. The five winning logo designs will be uploaded to our common website. The Erasmus+ Teams from each school will vote for the best representative logo. The deadline is 28th January.

The most voted among logos will be announced on our website and will get a price from each country on the first project meeting in Budapest, Hungary together with the winners of each school.
